

Budget- We came out of last year approx with \$900 in the bank. There a few things we had budgeted for but never spent the money on, sponsorships of other tournaments, some course improvement money that was not spent, etc. For this years budget we removed all sponsorships of events outside Vermont and shifted that cash to the course improvement fund, which will be about \$500. Chris Mayone mentioned that Matt A. was trying to permission from the town to maintain the course (cutting and mowing included) and some matching funds for new tee pads, tee pads is what we would like to spend the money on. Also a GMDGC sign/ pavilion is on the table.

GMPS- The Green Mountain point series will continue this year, \$200 has been budgeted for payouts plus \$1 for every player at all GMPS events. If the numbers are the same as last year we will raise an additional \$350. The divisions offered will be Pro, Pro Women, Pro Masters, AM1, AM2, Am Masters, Am Women, and Rec. The points series schedule is still being worked on but right now it is looking like the Sap Bucket (May 30), Blackfalls/ Calais (Aug 8/9), Randolph (June 27?), First Trax (Jun 13), Sugarbush (July 25), and Lyndon State College with the finals at Calais (Sep 12) again. Other events may include Johnson State, Oxbow, and Leddy Park.

Club Discs- We are out of GMDGC disc and minis and have budget money for 75 discs and minis. We are currently comparing companies with the following selection Innova (25 Pigs, 25 Star Crows, and 25 Star TLs w/ 75 GMDGC Star minis) and Discraft (25 Soft Magnets, 25 Comets, 25 XLs and 75 GMDGC minis). The 75 Sap bucket discs will come from the company we choose the purchase the club discs from.

Sap Bucket- The Sap Bucket will be held on May 30th this year, it will be a NEFA points event, a PDGA event, and a Vibram Open Qualifier. Pete Hess is TD this year and \$200 has been budgeted for running the event.

Ice Bucket- The Ice Bucket will be held this year on Jan. 24th, we have set of goal of raise \$1000 for the Waterbury Foodshelf. If you know of a company who would be willing to make a merchandise donation to give away to participants please contact them.

USDGC and PDGA MAJOR Events- The GMDGC will sponsor any GMDGC member for \$50 who qualifies for and participates in a PDGA major event (Am/ Pro Worlds, USDGC, Womens USDGC, and Am USDGC).
